Application Process:

WOLC offers a range of professional graduate and postgraduate courses including Business Management, Accountancy, Health and Social Care, Tourism and Hospitality Management. We offer Ofqual recognised qualifications from Ofqual recognised awarding bodies, with competitive fees and flexible study options allowing you to complete your qualification in a shorter time.



1. Choose your course

Choose a course to suit your needs, and check to see if you meet the entry conditions - we can help you if you are unsure.

2. Complete the application form

Application forms are available from our website or collect one direct from the college. Once completed, send it back to us by post or via email: admission@wolc.org.uk

3. Getting an Offer

Once we receive your application we will let you know whether we can make you an offer as soon as possible. We may ask you for some more information.

4. Accepting an Offer

If you receive a conditional offer letter and decide to accept it, you should let us know as soon as possible. You will also need to pay an admission fee to secure your place.

5. Starting your course

Once you have accepted the offer, provided any additional information requested, and paid your admission fee, we will confirm your place and send you details about enrolment and your course induction details.

FEES & FINANCIAL SUPPORT:

As part of our mission, WOLC aims to offer quality education and value for money. We price our course fees as competitively as possible, by cutting costs not quality. We also seek to provide access to education for as wide a range of students as possible.

Our courses consist of individual units or modules with a given number of Guided Learning Hours (GLH). The inclusive course fees cover the teaching costs for all the modules in the course plus course administration, registration, and student support costs. Longer courses and courses with more modules will cost more than shorter courses or courses with fewer modules. We can, however, reduce administrative and other expenses for longer-term costs by spreading them over time.

We can also offer various flexible instalment plans to allow students to spread their payments over the course of their studies. Please contact our admission advisor for a specific course fee.

City of Peterborough

Peterborough is an exciting city with a broad range of heritage attractions, country walking, water sports, modern art and even greyhound racing - there really is something for everyone.


